TOTAL NUMBER OF APPOINTED MEMBERS	Ten (10) + Two (2) Alternates (<i>C/SNA and IMD members</i>) every two (2) years
COMPOSITION	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The advisory board shall consist of ten (10) members and two (2) alternates who are <i>C/SNA/ANA</i> or <i>IMD</i> members. Five (5) advisory board members are appointed every two (2) years • The Chair shall be elected from among the current advisory board members

RESPONSIBILITIES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Contribute to the strategic goals of the Center and of ANA. • Review and recommend Center activities on issues of concern for nurses in any role or setting and to recommend to the ANA Board of Directors appropriate action. • Propose to the ANA Board of Directors matters requiring attention by the membership, including position statement and policy development, review, and revision. In doing so, it may be appropriate to work in partnership with other departments within ANA to forward a joint proposal to the ANA Board of Directors.
TERM OF OFFICE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Five (5) advisory board members shall be appointed in even years to serve terms of four (4) years or until a successor is appointed; • Appointment of alternate members shall only be for the duration of the appointments cycle or until a vacancy is scheduled to occur. • The Chair shall serve for a two-year (2-year) term and may be reappointed to serve a second term for a maximum of four (4) years.
TERM LIMIT	Members may serve two (2) consecutive terms
TIME COMMITMENT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The advisory board meets bimonthly by conference call for two (2) hours; • Members are assigned to subcommittees of the advisory board and should expect to participate in additional conference calls; • Members should expect to spend eight (8) hours a month reading different emails and reports; • Members should expect to spend an additional eight (8)

	hours a month participating in a workgroup activity. <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The Center holds an annual two-day meeting at the ANA headquarters office or in conjunction with a nursing ethics meeting.
