- The reports are tied to your specific school code.
- Students must choose the correct school name when applying for an APRN exam to ensure data accuracy.

<sup>1a</sup> - **Year of Candidate Graduation:** (3 Yr. capture) -Each row in this column designates the 3 most recent graduation years captured in the aggregate data report. For example: the 2025 school aggregate data report will capture candidates who sat for the certification exam during the 2025 reporting year whose graduation years are from 2023, 2024 and 2025. The most recent graduation year will have a breakdown of candidates per graduate degree level -MSN, DNP, Post-Grad.

<sup>1b</sup> - **Number of Candidates:** Each row under this column designates number of graduates both 1<sup>st</sup> time and repeat testers (per graduation year) who sat for the exam.

<sup>1c</sup> - **Number of 1st Time Candidates:** Designates the number of 1st time test takers for that graduation year

<sup>1d</sup> - **School Pass Rate 1st Time Candidates:** Designates the 1st time test takers % pass rate.

<sup>1e</sup> - **School Pass Rate:** Designates the overall school pass rate (%) of all 1st time and repeat testers combined.



# Breaking Down the 2025 Aggregate Data Report

## Review the 5 columns:

- The years the students graduated that tested in 2025.
- The number of test takers for each graduation year.
- The number of 1<sup>st</sup> time test takers for each graduation year.
- The pass rate of 1<sup>st</sup> time test takers for each graduation year.
- The overall pass rate for each graduation year.

**Starting January 1, 2026**, Candidates for ANCC APRN certification must pass their examination within **five (5) years** of degree conferral from their applicable APRN degree or post-graduate certification program.

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**Starting January 1, 2026**, for post-graduate certificate (PGC) applicants, only PGC APRN program accreditation will be accepted for eligibility for an institution's PGC program. Applicants must demonstrate their program held/holds an active PGC accreditation at the time of graduation.

# Eligibility Criteria

## Licensure

Hold a current, active RN license in a state or territory of the United States or hold the professional, legally recognized equivalent in another country.

## Graduate Education

Hold a **master's, post-graduate, or doctoral degree** from an accredited program:

- Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE)
- Accreditation Commission for Education in Nursing (ACEN)
- National League for Nursing (NLN) Commission for Nursing Education Accreditation (CNEA)

A minimum of **500** faculty-supervised clinical hours must be achieved.

## Graduate-Level Courses

Complete

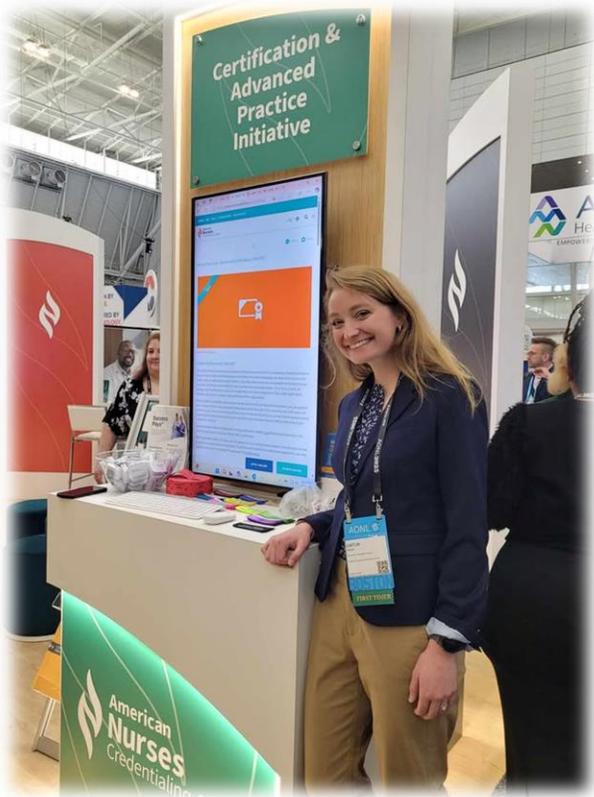
- Advanced physiology/pathophysiology
- Advanced health assessment
- Advanced pharmacology

## Content

- Health promotion and/or maintenance
- Differential diagnosis and disease management, (including the use and prescription of pharmacologic and nonpharmacologic interventions)
- **PMHNP ONLY:** Clinical training in at least two psychotherapeutic treatment modalities

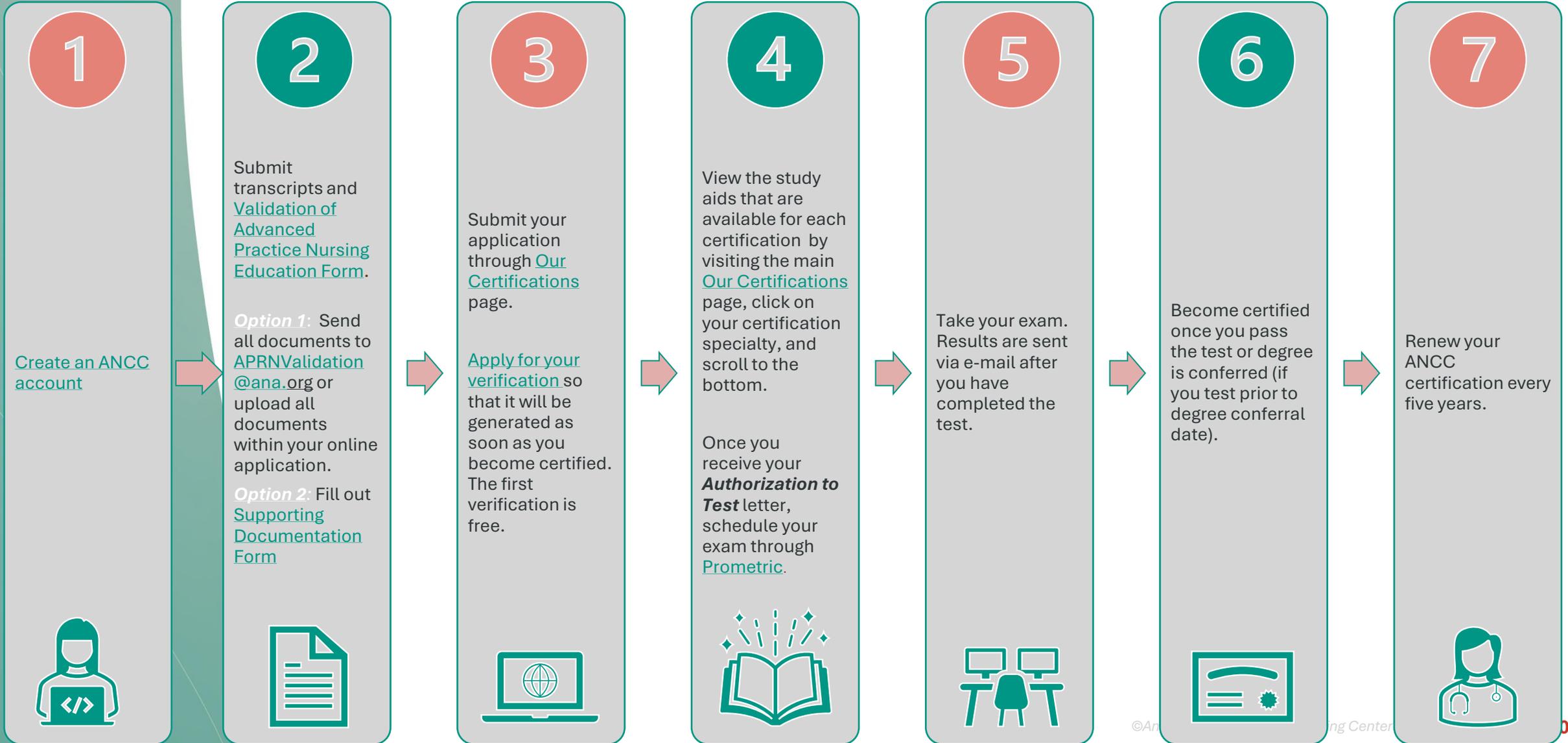

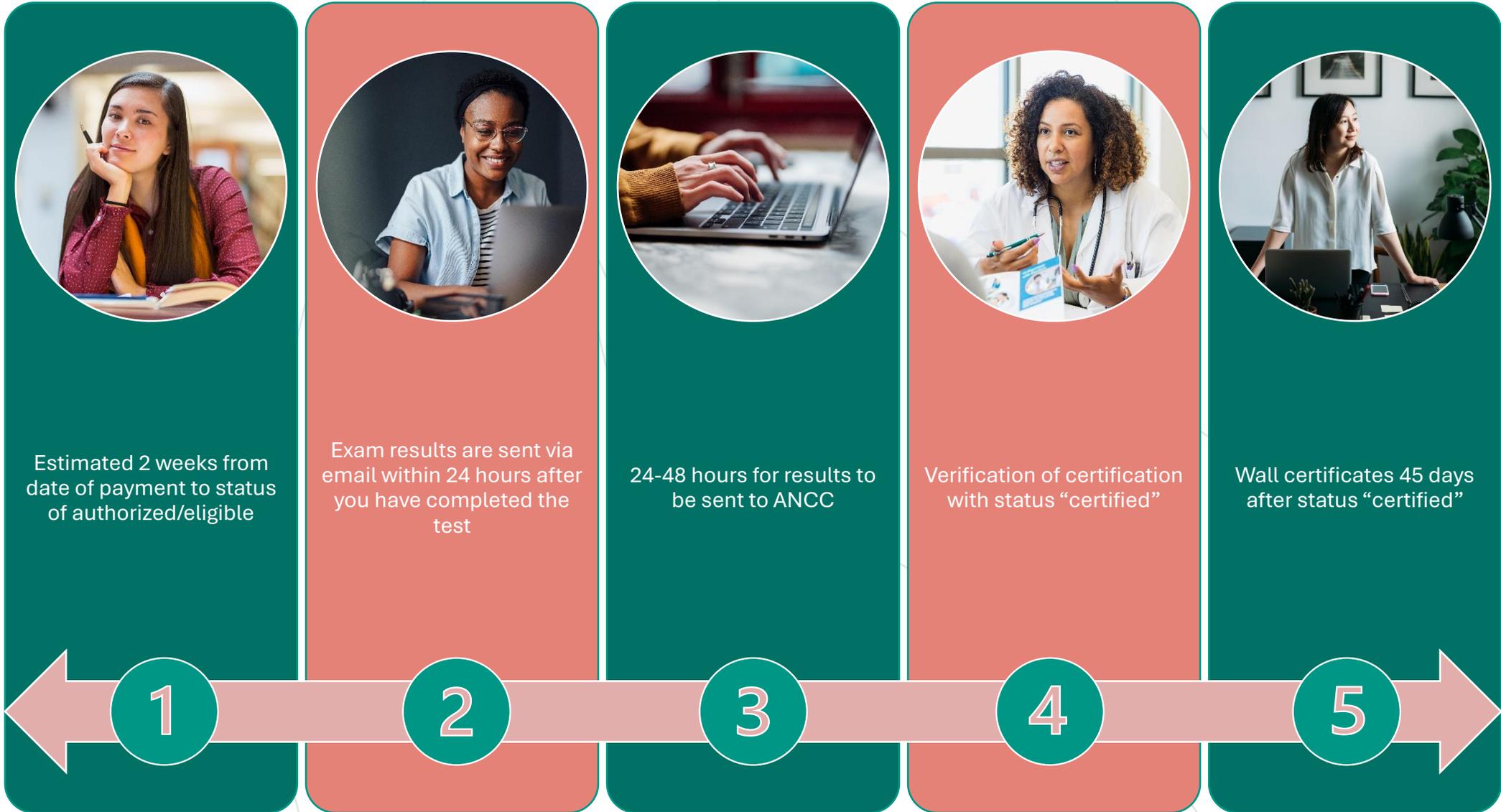

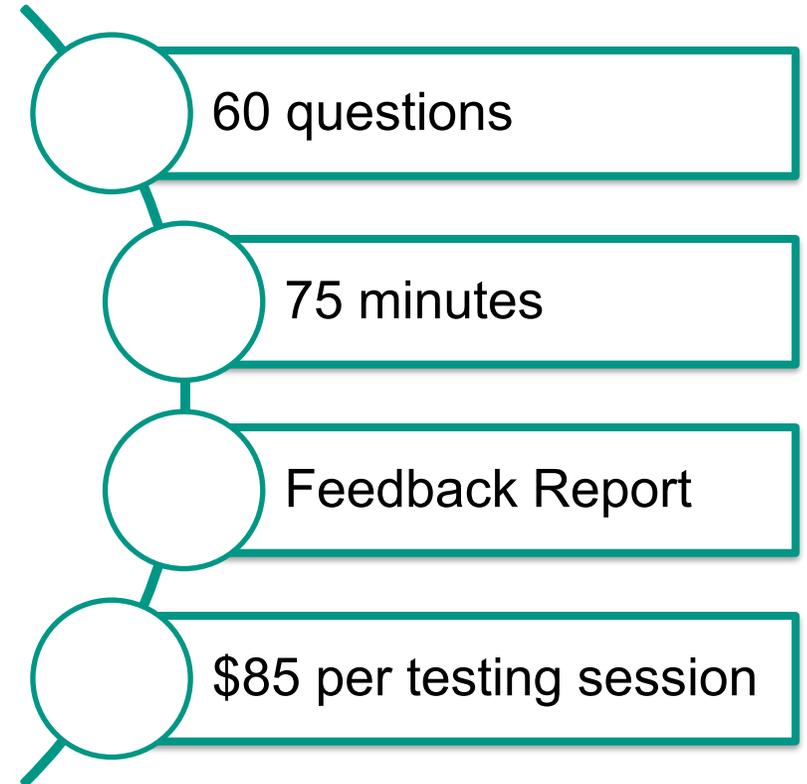

# Overview of Certification Test Development Cycle

- Certification exams are refreshed on a structured 3–5-year cycle
- Volunteer experts partner with staff and psychometricians at every stage.



- **Define Content**
  - Job Analysis
  - Content Outline and Specifications
- **Develop & Review the Exam**
  - Item Bank Review
  - Exam Form Review
  - Standard Setting
- **Maintain Exam Quality**
  - Exam Administration
  - On-going Item and Performance review



# How Can You Help With Certification Development

There are three main content expert volunteer position types:

- **Content Expert Panelists (CEP)** - Review and define exam content
- **Item Writers** - Develop and review exam questions.
- **Standard Setting Panelist** - Help establish passing standards

Eligible candidates also include APRN faculty with a minimum of three years of experience and at least 50% active clinical practice, including researchers.
