



Eligibility & Policy Updates






Starting January 1, 2026, Candidates for ANCC APRN certification must pass their examination within five (5) years of degree conferral from their applicable APRN degree or post-graduate certification program.

Starting January 1, 2026, for post-graduate certificate (PGC) applicants, only PGC APRN program accreditation will be accepted for eligibility for an institution's PGC program. Applicants must demonstrate their program held/holds an active PGC accreditation at the time of graduation.

APRN Core Course Review





- For students currently pursuing or starting a post-graduate program, we now offer a new service to help educators prepare their students for certification success.
- The APRN Core Course Review allows faculty members to submit Advanced Pharmacology, Advanced Health Assessment, and Advanced Pathophysiology courses for review against current ANCC certification eligibility criteria.
- Documents for this service can be submitted before or during a student's program for review by our team. Please follow the steps below to request review:
 - Submit a request via the <u>Core Course Review Survey</u>.
 - Provide details and supporting documentation from time of course, such as syllabi and/or course descriptions.

Steps for Students to Apply





Create an ANCC account





Submit the March 2025 VOE Form & transcripts

Option 1: Send all documents to **APRNValidation** @ana.org or upload all documents within your online application.

Option 2: Fill out Supporting Documentation Form





Submit vour application

Apply for your verification so that it will be generated as soon as you become certified. The first verification is free.






View the study aids that are available for each certification specialty by scrolling to the bottom.

Once vou receive your Authorization to Test letter, schedule your exam through Prometric.









Become certified once you pass the test or degree is conferred (if you test prior to degree conferral date).



Renew your **ANCC** certification every five years.









Application Processing Time





Estimated 3 weeks from date of payment to status of authorized/eligible



Exam results are sent via email within 24 hours after you have completed the test



24-48 hours for results to be sent to ANCC



Verification of certification with status "certified"



Wall certificates 45 days after status "certified"


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School Code Information



Education History





- The school code designation is a unique identifier for your ANCC school aggregate data/pass rate report information.
- It is important that schools have their accurate and up-to-date code to obtain their annual pass rates.
- Schools/Universities requesting to be added to the school code list or for official school name changes/updates, must complete the <u>ANCC School Code Add/School Name Change Form</u>.
- The form the must be sent to <u>certificationoutreach@ana.org</u>.

Yearly Pass Rate Reports

Aggregate Data Reports

- Contain data only for the calendar year
- Contains domain level performance for test-takers from the calendar year
- Available once per year (usually in the first quarter)

Opt-In Pass Rate Reports

- Contain calculated pass rates for last calendar year and last 3 calendar years
- •Includes a list of names of students who have opted in to sharing their data directly with their schools
- Can be requested anytime

Request the Report

- To support your accreditation efforts; we have updated our aggregate data (pass rate) reporting processes. Updated reports are now available upon request. Complete the <u>Updated Pass Rate Report Request Form &</u> <u>Attestation to receive the data.</u>
- Once data becomes available for the previous year, a notification will be sent out to APRN faculty and staff.


